

# 25th Anniversary Celebratory Functions and Activities

Major Functions and Activities specially organized by the College around the Anniversary Date of March 22, 2003 are listed as follows:-

1. "Train the Trainers" Workshop in collaboration with the Royal New Zealand College of General Practitioners on 15th-16th March 2003. The New Zealand presenters are: **Dr. Roy Morris**, **Dr. Greg Judkins**, and **Dr. Steven Lillis**. The objective of this workshop is "Preparing General Practitioners as Excellent Vocational Teachers".
2. The Chinese Society of General Practice will host the **WONCA Asia-Pacific Regional Conference** in Beijing in November 2003. To help their **Host Organizing Committee**, the College had already held one meeting with them in Kuming in July 2002, and took the opportunity of their presence in Hong Kong to play host to another of their HOC meetings in the afternoon of March 21 in a function room of the Academy Building. At a dinner in Repulse Bay given in honour of Invited Speakers to the Anniversary Scientific Meeting, visitors from Mainland China will also be invited.
3. **25th Anniversary Scientific Meeting**  
This is the major celebratory activity and will be held at the Hong Kong Academy of Medicine Jockey Club Building on 22nd March 2003 at 2:30 p.m. The **Opening Ceremony** of this **Scientific Meeting** will be performed by the **Hon. Chief Justice Mr. Andrew Li**, **Prof. Felice Lieh-Mak**, **Dr. Leong Che Hung**, **Dr. Peter C.Y. Lee** and **Dr. Donald Li**. The theme of the Scientific Meeting is "**Professional Performance and Training**". The Keynote speaker will be **Prof. Dame Lesley Southgate**, and Plenary speakers will include **Prof. Michael Kidd**, and **Prof. Yvonne Carter**.

Following the Opening Ceremony of the **Scientific Meeting**, the College will hold its **Sixteenth Fellowship Conferment Ceremony** at 4:30 p.m. The Anniversary Year Conferment Ceremony will be held conjointly with the **Hong Kong College of Community Medicine**, during which four Honorary Fellowships will be conferred. Amongst the recipients will be **Dr. Zhang Wenkang**, the Minister of Health, People's Republic of China.
5. Following the Conferment Ceremony, the **14th Dr. Sun Yat Sen Oration** will be given by **Dr. E.K. Yeoh**, Secretary for Health, Welfare and Food, who will speak on the topic: "**Medicine without the Medicine**".
6. The **Hong Kong College of Family Physicians** and the **Hong Kong College of Community Medicine** will co-host the **Conjoint Conferment Dinner** at the Grand Hall of the Hong Kong Academy of Medicine Jockey Club Building on 22nd March at 7:15 p.m.
7. The College took the opportunity of the presence in Hong Kong of so many local and foreign GP/FM experts to convene in the afternoon of Sunday 23rd March a round table discussion on "**Family Medicine Training**".
8. Similarly, the College took the opportunity of the presence in Hong Kong of **Prof. Dame Lesley Southgate**, the **President of Royal College of General Practitioners**, to sponsor a joint meeting with the **Medical Council of Hong Kong** and the **Hong Kong Academy of Medicine** to discuss the topic of "**Professional Performance**" in the afternoon of March 24, 2003, with **Prof. Southgate** as Moderator.
9. A special production of a **VCD documenting College activities** during the year is now being produced, and will be distributed to all members in the near future.
10. A special **25th Anniversary Commemorative Brochure** should be ready for distribution at the Scientific Meeting.
