## Result

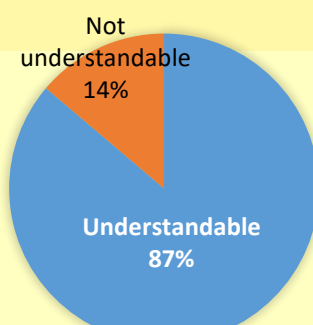
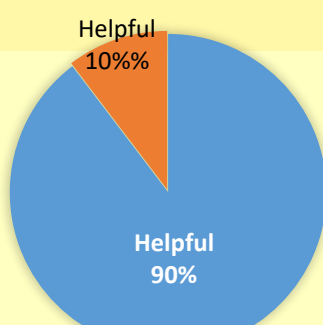
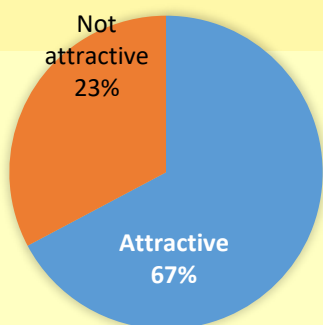
- 58 samples have been collected
